Online Bill Access

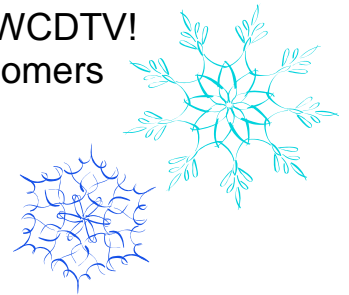
Access your Webster-Calhoun invoice electronically and you don't have to wait for your bill to arrive in the mail!

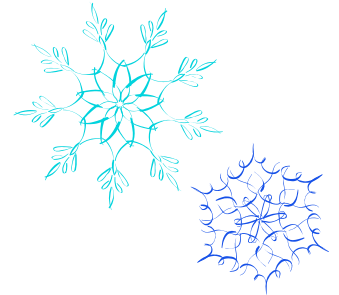
High School Seniors interested in scholarship opportunities may want to check out the Foundation for Rural Service web site at www.frs.org.
