Thor Fire Station Rebuilds

Downtown Thor, Iowa was ablaze back on December 10, 2021. The old Humboldt Trust & Savings Bank and a neighboring vacant building were engulfed in fire. Thor's Fire Chief, Kevin Olson, responded to the scene and began moving trucks out of the fire's path in his own fire station, located next door. Six fire departments responded to help extinguish the flames as the fire ultimately destroyed the two vacant buildings and caused structural damage to the Thor-Norway Fire Station. Ann Street, the main road in downtown Thor, looks a little different today.

Clay Hansen, project coordinator for the fire station fundraising effort, is appreciative of the support. "We are really blessed because we started off with a nice insurance reimbursement check, we received a grant from the Humboldt County Community Foundation, and other groups within the community came forward to donate."

Due to these funds, the fire department has been able to tear down and rebuild their station and even add a few essential amenities. One new feature is a door at the rear of the station allowing a bay for the water truck to drive through for filling, many rural fires require the department to haul water.

Hansen, a former volunteer fireman, is excited about the new building. "I think it will help stimulate the local fire department and volunteers. They take a lot of pride in what they do."
