She lives in Gowrie with her boyfriend Patrick, and their golden retriever Harper.

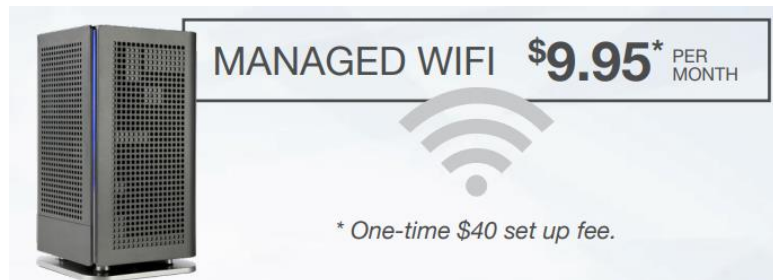


New School Year New Connection

Affordable Connectivity Program

The Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) is an FCC benefit program that helps ensure that households can afford the broadband they need for work, school, and more.

The benefit provides a discount of up to \$30.00 per month toward internet service for eligible households and up to \$75.00 per month for households on qualifying Tribal lands. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100.00 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers if they contribute more than \$10.00 and less than \$50.00 toward the purchase price.

The ACP is limited to one monthly service discount and one device discount per household.
